

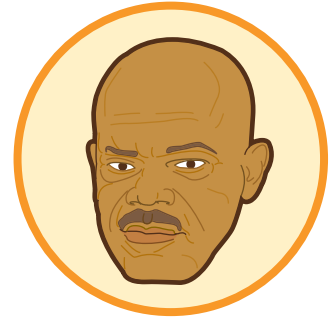


SNAKES ON AN ISLAND

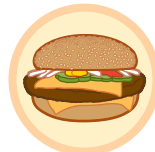
